1. Geography and **Geology (3D physical map of the planet)**: Glaciers, Oceans, Monsoons, Rivers, Mountains
2. Migration to the subcontinent, Neolithic people, **cave paintings**, utensils, Stone Age, southern India habitat, sea voyage, central India habitat, northeast settlements
